MINUTES OF MARCH 16, 1987, were approved as written on MOTION by Dr. Scholes.
Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT FOR MARCH was accepted upon MOTION by Dr. Lehrman.
Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #377 and #501 through #637 and #701 through #706 totaling \$707,749.53.

A MOTION by Dr. Scholes approved the disbursements and transfer of funds and acknowledged the March payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: President Meyerhoeffer reported the following:

1. Contracts have been mailed to total staff and faculty at a 7 percent increase for everyone other than administration. The administration increase is approximately 5 percent.
2. When the college accreditation visit was made about three and one-half years ago, there were six general areas of recommendation. An interim team was here last week to review those six recommendations. Before they left, their verbal response indicated that they would write a very positive report and were very pleased with the progress that CSI had made.
3. Graduation will be May 8. We would like to invite the board to have dinner with the speaker at 5:30 p.m.
4. We received a proposal from King VideoCable on the basketball schedule and other events on campus. Within the next ten days, we want to send out and ask for quotations on broadcasting of all the basketball games.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT CONTINUED:


5. The board received a copy of the college policy on the national privacy act. If there are no questions, then the policy will continue to be enforced.

6. For the past ten years we have worked with businesses in the area to complete the north campus road. The private businesses along the road can form an LID, and although the city or the college cannot participate in the LID, they will have an obligation to pay their share. There will be curbing and sidewalk from Blue Lakes to the Expo Center.

7. A local luncheon organization wants to use the area south and east of the dorm for a soccer field. If this meets with the approval of the board, the organization will be asked to provide the college with a certificate of liability insurance.


